

**ANNOUNCEMENT AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE ORGANISED AT THE
NATIONAL ELECTION COMMISSION'S HEADQUARTERS ON 26 Nov. 2006 AT
11.20 P.M.**

On 26 November At 10.20 p.m. at the headquarters of the National Election Commission a press conference was held during which the „Announcement of the national Election Commission on the partial unofficial results of the vote determined as at 11.08 p.m.” was presented.

On the basis of information on the results of the vote received electronically from 10 371 i.e. 91.09 % of the protocols on the results of the vote as approved by the territorial election commission out of the total 11 385 of the protocols on the vote, the National Election Commission announces the following information.

I.

1. Partial unofficial results of the vote in the elections for the community leaders and city mayors and presidents are the following:
 - 1) Number of the eligible voters was 12 993 682;
 - 2) Number of the ballot cards issued by 5 027 322;
 - 3) Turnout was 38.69%.

Out of the total 827 of community leaders and city mayors and presidents elected in the 2nd round of the election the results of the elections were determined in 160 communities and cities.
